



### How is our integrated care partnership (ICP) driving the future vision for health and care in our system?

# Are we a 'convenor' partnership?

In a 'convenor' partnership, the ICP aims to bring a broad coalition of partners together to set and pursue shared objectives and take collective action.

# Are we a 'change' partnership?

In a 'change' partnership, the ICP brings together partners to identify cross-system priorities, to immerse itself in their detail, and to drive transformative change to provide maximum impact for the population it serves.

### Are we a 'challenge' partnership?

'Challenge' ICPs provide a counterweight – or challenge – to what is often the NHS's focus on short-term priorities, such as forthcoming winters, elective backlogs, acute performance, and GP waiting times.

#### Or are we pursuing a combination of all three?

#### How are we embodying the essential characteristics of effective ICPs?



#### Have we built a partnership of equals – including in how ICPs are resourced, organised and presented?

How are we **enabling** and empowering local decision-making?



How are **embedding accountability** in everything we do across the whole partnership? How are we **promoting a trusting and transparent culture** across our partners? Are we **enabling all our partners to get involved** – including the wider VCSE sector, academia, business etc?



Have we done the hard yards to **get the governance right for our ICP** – especially in our unique system context?

Are we **embedding a focus on the long-term vision** for the whole system?
