Integrity: Choosing to do the right thing every day.

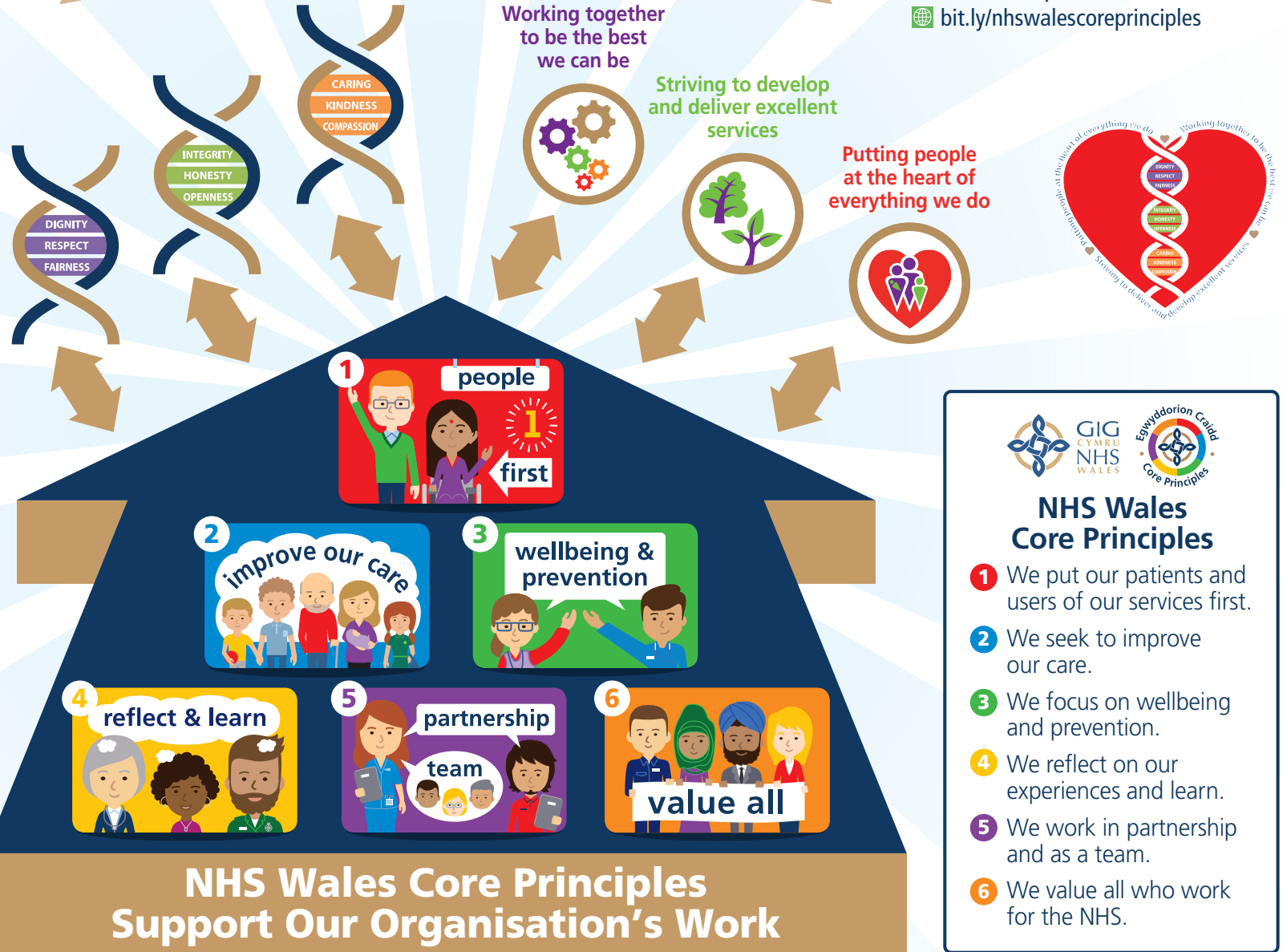
Honesty: Being transparent and accountable about what we are planning and doing.
